1. By this common order, RFA No.57 and 5127 of 2018 shall stand disposed of.

2. The learned counsel representing the parties are ad-idem that qua assessment of the market value of the acquired land, the matter in issue is covered by the judgment passed in **Kewal Singh vs. Punjab State and others (RFA No.5727 of 2013 and other connected cases, decided on 10.05.2016).**

3. However, the learned State counsel submits that the appellants are not entitled to interest for the period of delay which is more than 1500



days, in filing the appeal.

4. On 20.08.2019, while condoning the delay, the Court observed as under:-

“However, the appellants shall not be entitled to interest for the period of delay, in case the appeal is allowed.”

5. Keeping in view the position, the appeals are disposed of in terms of the judgment passed in **Kewal Singh vs. Punjab State and others (RFA No.5727 of 2013 and other connected cases, decided on 10.05.2016)** with stipulation that the appellant(s) shall not be entitled to interest for 1556 days.

6. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
