HARSH BUNGER, J. (ORAL)

1. Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, herein is, *inter alia*, for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of the order dated 12.08.2024 (Annexure P-3) passed by the District Development Panchayat Officer, Ludhiana dismissing the complaint dated 24.01.2024 (Annexure P-1) of the petitioner.

1.1 A further prayer has been made to issue directions to the District Development and Panchayat Officer to objectively decide the complaint of the petitioner (Annexure P-1) in a fair, impartial manner and in accordance with law.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondents No. 2, 3 and 5 that whenever the auction

of the shop in question is scheduled, notice in that regard be sent to the petitioner so as to enable him to participate in the auction.

3. At this stage, Mr. Navneet Singh, Senior DAG, Punjab appears on behalf of the respondents/State, in pursuance of the advance copy of paper book having already been supplied to him. He, on instructions from Ms. Kavita, BDPO, Sidhwa Bet, submits that the auction of the shop in question is tentatively scheduled for 21.05.2025 and a due intimation in writing in that regard or any other actual date which may be fixed for holding the auction will be given to the petitioner.

4. Keeping in view the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition stands disposed of accordingly. The concerned BDPO, Sidhwa Bet would send a prior notice to the petitioner with regard to the auction of the shop in question.

5. All pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
