1. On the last date of hearing i.e. 11.08.2025 the following
order was passed: -

“The appellant has filed the instant appeal impugning the order dated 09.01.2025 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Jalandhar, whereby an application filed by the appellant under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.19 dated 15.02.2024 registered under Sections 363, 366-A, 376 & 120-B of Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 3(2)V & 3(2)V(A) of Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989 at Police Station Division No.5, Jalandhar, has been dismissed.

On receipt of advance copy of the appeal, Mr. Adhiraj Singh, A.A.G., Punjab has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.1-State and has produced copy of

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order dated 08.08.2025 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge-cum-FTC(POCSO), Jalandhar, wherein it has been recorded that the petitioner has been declared as proclaimed offender vide order dated 01.08.2025 and therefore, the instant appeal is not maintainable.
