1. Present petition has been filed by the petitioners seeking issuance of direction to the official respondents, to protect their life and liberty from the hands of the private respondents.

2. Learned State counsel produces copy of the order dated 19.08.2025, passed by SHO, PS Sadar Rajpura, District Patiala, wherein it has been specifically mentioned that father of petitioner No.1 – Ranjt Kaur, and other family members have joined the inquiry and stated that they have no objection to the marriage of Ranjt Kaur with petitioner No.2 – Satwinder Singh. They further stated that they have no intention of interfering in the personal life of petitioners or causing them any harm.

3. It is thereupon, that the concerned SHO has concluded that no threat perception is found to be existing at this stage, so no action is warranted.

4. Copy of the said speaking order dated 19.08.2025 is taken on record. Registry is directed to tag the same at the appropriate place on the file. Copy thereof has also been handed to counsel for the petitioners.

5. Faced with the situation, counsel for the petitioners does not want to press the present petition.

6. Accordingly, present petition stands dismissed, being not pressed, at this stage.
