1. Feeling aggrieved against the alleged inaction on the part of respondent authorities, petitioner has approached this Court by way of instant petition, seeking issuance of appropriate directions to the respondents No. 1 to 3 to take action regarding arrest of the respondent No. 4 accused in FIR No. 216 dated 06.07.2024 under Section 103(1) and Section 61(2) of BNS and Section 25 of the Arms Act, Police Station Kasola, District Rewari (Annexure P-1).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been running from pillar to post but his grievance was not being redressed by the respondent authorities. Having been left with no other option, petitioner has approached the Superintendent of Police, Rewari, Haryana respondent No.2 by way of representation dated 21.10.2024 (Annexure P-6), but the same is also pending

decision. He also submits that the petitioner will be satisfied in case respondent No.2 is directed to look into the matter and take appropriate steps, in accordance with law.

3. Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and after going through the case file, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the the Superintendent of Police, Rewari, Haryana respondent No.2 to consider the representation dated 21.10.2024 (Annexure P-6) and decide the same by passing an appropriate order thereon, strictly as per law, within a period of two weeks from today.
