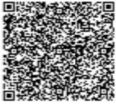

AARADHNA SAWHNEY, J. (ORAL)

1. The present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India has been preferred by the petitioners for issuance of a direction to respondents No.2 & 3 to consider their representation 05.08.2025 (Annexure P-3) for protecting the life and liberty of the petitioners and to restrain the private respondents No.4 to 8 from harassing or interfering in their peaceful life and liberty.

2. It is, *inter alia*, contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners had given representation dated 05.08.2025 (Annexure P-3) but till date no action thereon has been taken. He submits that for the purpose of this petition, the petitioners will be satisfied if directions are given to respondent No.2 to consider and dispose of the representation dated 05.08.2025 (Annexure P-3) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner.

3. Notice of motion to official respondents only.



4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Kamalpreet Bawa, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3-State.

5. After considering the respective submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioners and the averments made in the petition, without commenting on the merits thereof, the present petition is disposed of with direction to respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Nawanshahar to consider and dispose of the representation dated 05.08.2025 (Annexure P-3) in accordance with law in an expeditious manner. The decision so taken be intimated to the petitioners as well.
