SANJAY VASHISTH, J.

1. Present criminal writ petition has been filed under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India, seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of habeas corpus against Respondent No. 7 for the production of the petitioner's wife, namely Bholi Devi, who has been illegally removed from the custody of petitioner in connivance with respondents No. 4 and 5.

2. On 08.08.2025, following order was passed:

"1. Present petition has been filed by the petitioner, seeking issuance of direction against respondent No.7 for production of his wife namely Bholi Devi, who has been illegally removed from his custody, in connivance with respondent Nos.4 and 5.

2. From the petition, it is noticed that respondent No.7 is the wife of the petitioner - Ram Lubhaya. Respondent No.6 is sister of respondent No.7, and respondent No.5 is husband of respondent No.6.

3. Allegation is that Bholi Devi (respondent No.7) and three children of the petitioner namely Manav, Gagan and daughter Suneha, have been illegally detained by them in their house.

4. From the pleadings mentioned in the present petition, it is found that allegedly, respondent No.7 was abducted by



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respondent Nos.5 and 6 on 28.12.2023 at about 9.00 P.M. from the house of the petitioner; along with 2/3 tola of gold ornaments and Rs.30,000/- of cash amount, which were lying there in the house of the petitioner.

5. *Counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner seeks an adjournment as arguing counsel is not available.*

6. *On request, adjourned to 28.08.2025.”*

3. On instructions from ASI Jagir Chand, learned State counsel submits that statement of petitioner-Ram Lubhaya, has already been recorded, and as per his statement, he has filed a divorce petition and intends to await its final decision.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner also confirms the information provided by the learned State counsel and, accordingly, seeks permission to withdraw present petition at this stage.

5. In view of the above, present petition is dismissed as withdrawn at this stage.
