The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under section 482 BNSS for blanket/anticipatory bail to the petitioner and directing the SHO, Sunam/ DSP, Sunam to not to arrest the petitioner at the instance of respondent no. 2 and in case the petitioner is required to be arrested in any FIR registered at the instance of respondent no 2 then 15 days advance notice may kindly be given to the petitioner as the matter in dispute is purely of civil nature.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gursewak Singh, submits that the instant petition is a clear abuse of the process of law, being wholly frivolous and misconceived. It is stated that a complaint has been lodged by the complainant, Deepak Kumar, against the present petitioner. To investigate the said complaint, both the petitioner and the complainant have been called to the Police

Station for inquiry, without any intention to arrest the petitioner. Furthermore, no FIR has been registered against the petitioner to date.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition.

Prayer is accepted.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
