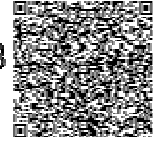

SUBHAS MEHLA, J. (Oral)

1. Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in criminal case bearing FIR No.118 dated 11.03.2025 registered under Sections 333, 118(2), 191(3), 190, 351 (3) of BNS, 2023 at Police Station Goindwal Sahib, District Tarn Taran.

2. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation as per directions of this Court vide order dated 12.08.2025 and his custodial interrogation is no more required in this case.

3. Learned State counsel has not refuted the aforesaid assertions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and on instructions from ASI Harjinder Singh submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation but weapon of offence has not been recovered from his possession and Section 238 of BNS added later on. Learned State counsel fairly admitted that the



petitioner is not required by the police for further investigation or custodial interrogation.

4. In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 12.08.2025 is hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as provided under Section 482(2) of the BNSS.
