1. The present petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of Constitution of India seeking issuance of directions to respondent No.3 to take action on the parole application dated 28.05.2025.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has recently filed a parole application dated 28.05.2025 before the District Magistrate, Bathinda raising its grievances as mentioned in the present petition but the same has not yet been considered and no action has been taken thereon. He has further submitted that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.3-District Magistrate, Bathinda to decide the aforesaid parole application filed by the petitioner and take necessary action thereon.
