Learned State counsel has submitted that the order passed by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court on 26.08.2022 has been complied with and has further pointed out that one FIR no.28 dated 21.10.2023 under Sections 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC at Police Station Zirakpur, SAS Nagar has been registered against the petitioner Krishan Kumar Goyal.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that in reply-affidavit, reference has been made in paragraph 7 to the fact that a report was received from the Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar. It is submitted that the respondent be directed to supply the said report and the petitioners be granted liberty to take all remedies in law with respect to said



report as well as FIR registered against the petitioner Krishan Kumar Goyal.

3. Learned State counsel has submitted that he would supply the report, as mentioned in paragraph 7, received from the Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar to learned counsel for the petitioners within a period of two weeks.

4. Keeping in view the above said facts and circumstances, the present petition is disposed of granting liberty to the petitioners as sought. The respondents would be bound by the statement made before this Court.
