1. The Criminal writ petition has been filed by the petitioner under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, seeking direction to official respondents to protect her life and liberty and that of her family members, at the hands of private respondents. Respondent No. 3 is also sought to be directed to look into representation dated 06.08.2025 (Annexure P-4) submitted by the petitioner in time bound manner.

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if appropriate direction is issued to respondent No.3- Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga, Punjab to decide the representation dated 06.08.2025 (Annexure P-4) moved by the petitioner and take necessary action.

3. Notice of motion to official respondents only.

4. Mr. Hardeep Singh Wadhwa, DAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that the

needful shall be done in due course.

5. Keeping in view the limited prayer made by the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3- Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga, Punjab to decide the aforesaid representation dated 06.08.2025 (Annexure P-4) submitted by the petitioner within a period of two months from today by passing a speaking order in accordance with law and take necessary action, if so required.

6. However, if, respondent No.3 does not find any substance in the allegations levelled in the representation (Annexure P-4), the petitioner shall be informed as per mandate of law.
