The present application has been filed by the applicant-petitioner for placing on record Annexures C-1 to C-4.

The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023 in case bearing FIR No.87 dated 25.04.2025 registered under Sections 109, 126(2), 117(2), 115(2), 324(4), 351(2), 191(3) and 190 of BNS, 2023 at Police Station Lehra, District Sangrur.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 13.08.2025, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

A reply dated 16.09.2025 by way of an affidavit of Deepinderpal Singh, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division, Lehra, District Sangrur has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record. He on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 13.08.2025 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS.

Petition stands disposed of.
