Petitioner has filed this petition under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India read with Section 482 of Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of appropriate direction to respondents No. 2 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of petitioner and his family members from private respondents No. 5 and 6.

In compliance of order dated 23.10.2024 issued by a Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, learned State counsel has filed status report dated 09.12.2024 and the same is taken on record. Further submits that perusal of aforesaid status report indicates that complaints given by the petitioner have been thoroughly considered and they have been recommended to be consigned to record and further the mother and wife of the petitioner are involved in 07 cases registered under the provisions of NDPS Act and the Excise Act and present petition has been filed only to put pressure on the jurisdictional police authorities not to perform their statutory duties and present petition is totally mis-conceived one and further in case the petitioner is required for investigation in any manner, prior notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C. would be served upon him.

In view of the status report filed by State of Punjab, no further directions are required to be issued in the present petition and the same is hereby disposed of accordingly.
