1. The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 482 of Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking quashing of FIR No.106 dated 30.07.2023 registered under Section 306 of Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Hargobindpur, District Batala (Annexure P-1) as well as all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 06.09.2024 (Annexure P-2) arrived at between the parties.
