1. Seeking directions to the respondents to disburse the arrears of enhanced pay in the notional/corresponding pay w.e.f. 01.01.2016 at Rs.2,17,560/- up to 14.07.2019 i.e. the time period up to which the petitioner worked with respondent No.2, the instant petition has been filed.

2. After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that with regard to his grievance, the petitioner has already submitted representation dated 27.03.2024 (Annexure P-7) but the respondents have not taken any action thereupon till date. He contends that the petitioner would be satisfied at this stage, in case respondent No.3- Secretary, Haryana Human Rights Commission, Nirmal Sadan, Sector 33-A, Chandigarh is directed to consider and decide the representation dated 27.03.2024 (Annexure P-7) submitted by the petitioner, by passing a speaking and reasoned order in a time bound

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manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Dr. (Ms.) Malvika Singh, DAG, Haryana enters appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and prays for some time to complete instructions and file response, if necessary. She, however, does not have any objection to the above request.

5. Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, by directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide the representation dated 27.03.2024 (Annexure P-7) by passing a reasoned and speaking order within a period of three months of the receipt of certified copy of this order.

6. Needless to mention that if upon considering the said representation, in case any amount is found due and payable to the petitioner(s), the same shall be disbursed in favour of the petitioner(s) within a further period of two months.
