1. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to personally monitor the investigation of the case bearing FIR No.0192 dated 27.06.2021 registered under Sections 323/447/427/379/148/149 of IPC at Police Station Kamboj, Police District Amritsar Rural, Punjab and to transfer the investigation to some senior police officer for proper, fair and impartial investigation.

2. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Joginder Singh, at the very outset, submits that nothing survives in the present petition as the investigating agency has examined the veracity of the allegations made by the petitioner in FIR (*supra*) twice and cancellation report has been submitted before the jurisdictional Court on both occasions. Recently, the second cancellation report has been submitted on 17.04.2025, as such, the petitioner has alternative remedies i.e. either to file protest petition or to pursue his remedies before the jurisdictional Court.



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3. In view of the above, present petition stands disposed of as having been rendered as infructuous. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to oppose the cancellation report by moving an appropriate application before the learned jurisdictional Court.

4. The jurisdictional Court is directed to consider the cancellation report in terms of the judgment passed by this Court in ***Pawan Kharbanda Vs. State of Punjab and another, CRM-M-3193 of 2025***, after providing adequate opportunity to the petitioner.

5. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, also stand(s) disposed of.
