JASJIT SINGH BEDI, J. (Oral)

The prayer in the Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for the issuance of a writ, order or direction especially in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents No.1, 2 and 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners as they are being threatened at the instance of respondent Nos.5 to 8.

None appears for the petitioner.

The learned State Counsel and the learned counsel for private respondent Nos.5 to 8 contend that it is a case where the child of the petitioners died in the Nursing Home of respondent No.5. As per the Board of Doctors constituted by the Civil Surgeon, Amritsar, no negligence was found on the part of the Hospital, where the delivery and treatment took place. However, as the petitioners had made allegations against the Board of

Doctors, the matter has been referred for an inquiry to PGI Chandigarh, where it is pending enquiry.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the liberty to the petitioner to avail his remedies in accordance with law.
