1. Instant 2nd petition has been filed under Section 483 of BNSS, 2023 seeking regular bail in case FIR No.79 dated 15.11.2022 under Sections 8/18/21/25/27/29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station NCB, Chandigarh (Place of Seizure: Jurisdiction of P.S. Dugri, Ludhiana).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is behind bars since 18.11.2022.

3. After arguing at length, learned counsel for the petitioner has fairly submitted that he does not wish to press the present petition at this stage and the same may be dismissed as not pressed.

4. However, learned counsel for the respondent-UOI (NCB) has submitted that this Court had already given direction for expediting the trial. He further submits that out of total 99 prosecution witnesses, only 10 witnesses

have been examined till date. He submits that the prosecution is making its earnest efforts to conclude the trial at the earliest.

5. Accordingly, dismissed as withdrawn at this stage.
