Petition herein is, *inter alia*, for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus, directing the official respondents to allot land measuring 23 Bigha-8 Biswa in any of the villages falling within Revenue District Gurugram, in lieu of the land earlier allotted in favour of Tara Chand (grandfather) and Ganga Ram (predecessor-in-interest of the petitioners) at Village Karheda and Village Uleta, District Gurugram, where un-allotted land of respondent No.3 is still available.

2. Learned senior counsel for the petitioners, at the outset, submits that the petitioners would be satisfied in case time bound directions are issued to respondent No.1 – Financial Commissioner Revenue-cum-

Additional Chief Secretary, Revenue and Disaster Management Department, Haryana, to take action on legal notice dated 12.03.2025 (Annexure P-8).

3. At this stage, learned State counsel submits that the office is in the process of reconstructing the file, and in any case, the aforesaid legal notice dated 12.03.2025 (Annexure P-8) shall be considered and decided by the Financial Commissioner Revenue-cum-Additional Chief Secretary, Revenue and Disaster Management Department, Haryana/competent authority, after affording due opportunity of hearing to all concerned parties, within a period of four months from today, in accordance with law.

4. Keeping in view the aforesaid submissions made by learned State counsel, no further orders are required to be passed in the present writ petition and the same is accordingly disposed of.

5. All the pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
