1. The present Criminal Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a Writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and her son from the hands of her husband Bikramjit Singh and his goons and further to take appropriate legal action in accordance with law on the complaint No.3265/SSP dated 31.05.2025 given by the petitioner to respondent No.3, which was further marked to SHO Women Cell.

2. Status report dated 31.08.2025 by way of an affidavit of Harmandeep Singh Hans, Senior Superintendent of Police, District SAS Nagar, filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3-State is taken on record.

3. According to the status report, representation moved by the petitioner has been disposed of and direction has been issued for registration



of an FIR. So far as the issue of providing protection to the petitioner is concerned, the petitioner has been given the mobile number of the concerned SHO.

4. Accordingly, no further action is called for and the present petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police as well as SHO that if any threat perception is found to be true, then protection as admissible in law shall be provided to the petitioner and her son as and when required. In case, concerned Senior Superintendent of Police is of the view that no protection is required, then speaking order shall be passed and communicated to the petitioner.
