1. Prayer in the present petition is for directing respondents No.1 and 2 to fix the seniority of the petitioners as per the merit list prepared by the Haryana Staff Selection Commission alongwith a further prayer for directing respondents No.1 and 2 to grant deemed date of promotion to them after fixing date of seniority.
2. After arguing at some length, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that with regard to the grievance, the petitioners have already served a legal notice dated 27.05.2025 (Annexure P-14) but no action has been taken thereupon till date. He contends that the petitioners would be satisfied at this stage, in case respondent No.2-Director General, Health Services, Haryana is directed to consider and decide the said legal notice, in a time bound manner in accordance with law.

4. Dr. (Ms.) Malvika Singh, DAG Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and prays for some time to complete instructions and file response, if necessary. She, however, does not have any objection to the above request.

Accordingly, the present petition is **disposed of** with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, by directing respondent No.2-Director General, Health Services, Haryana to consider and decide the legal notice dated 27.05.2025 (Annexure P-14) and to pass a well reasoned and speaking order thereupon in accordance with law, expeditiously and preferably within a period of 04 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
