1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.83 dated 22.07.2025, registered under Sections 305, 61(2), 316(4) and 318(4) BNS, 2023 at Police Station Cheema, District Sangrur.
2. Vide order dated 19.08.2025, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 19.08.2025, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such her interim bail may be made absolute.
4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Avtar Singh has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and she is no more required for further investigation.



- 5. In view of the above, interim order dated 20.08.2025 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482 (2) B.N.S.S.
- 6. Petition stands allowed.
