The prayer in the present petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for the release of detenue namely, Santosh Kumar S/o Bhawani Parsad who is stated to be illegal detention of respondent No.3.

On 17.08.2025, the following order was passed:-

“This is a criminal writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for the release of detenue, namely, Santosh Kumar son of Bhawani Parsad who is stated to be in illegal detention of respondent no.3.

Notice of motion 27.08.2025.

Meanwhile, the Registry is directed to appoint a Warrant Officer who shall search for the whereabouts of the alleged detenue, namely, Santosh Kumar at the address(s) mentioned in the petition or at any other place(s) as may be indicated by the petitioner, and if, the alleged detenue is found to be in illegal custody of respondent no.3, he be got released forthwith. The fee of the Warrant Officer shall be determined

by the Registry, as per Rules and is to be borne by the petitioner. The report of the Warrant Officer be also placed on record before the next date of hearing.”

In compliance of the aforementioned order, the report of the Warrant Officer has been placed on record as per which the petitioner was detained in FIR No.213 dated 07.08.2025 U/s 305, 331(4) BNS, 2023 P.S. Phase-I, SAS Nagar on 16.08.2025.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.
