The instant contempt petition alleges willful disobedience of order dated 04.12.2023 passed in CWP-22865-2012, vide which the following directions were passed:-

“7. In light of the above, the right of consideration for promotion having been taken away for which the petitioner is entitled to, this writ petition deserves to be allowed, and is accordingly, allowed. The respondents are directed to consider the case of the petitioner for promotion from the year 2009 by creating a supernumerary post till the person who was posted in his place was further promoted. Notional fixation shall be done for the said period and actual benefits shall be given to the petitioner only after the date respondent No.6 has been promoted. Consequential shall follow. Exercise be done within a period of three months.”

2. Learned State counsel has produced a copy of order dated 16.01.2025 as per which, the petitioner has been promoted to the post of Clerk, subject to outcome of the LPA (LPA-1296-2024).

3. That being so, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court.



- 4. The contempt petition is accordingly disposed of. Rule stands discharged.
- 5. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
