1. Prayer in the present petition is for directing respondents to grant 2nd and 3rd A.C.P. with all the consequential benefits to the petitioners which is due since 2006.

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners contends that the issue involved in the present case is covered by the judgment dated 05.03.2025 passed by a Division Bench of this Court in **LPA-1865-2015** titled as '**State of Haryana and others** Vs. **Parmanand and others**' and other connected case(s) and prays to consider the claim of the petitioners in light of the same. He contends that with regards to their claim, the petitioners have already submitted a representation dated 20.05.2025 (Annexure P-3) and they would be satisfied in case respondent(s) are directed to consider and decide the said representation in accordance with law as well as in view of the judgment dated 05.03.2025 of the Division



Bench passed in the matter of *Parmanand and others (supra)*.

3. Learned State counsel does not dispute the aforesaid factual position and has no objection for considering the claim of the petitioners in accordance with law.

4. Accordingly, the present petition is **disposed of** with the consent of the parties and without commenting anything on the merits of the case with a direction to respondent(s)-authorities to take note of the representation dated 20.05.2025 (Annexure P-3) in accordance with law as well as in view of the aforesaid judgment dated 05.03.2025 of the Division Bench passed in the matter of *Parmanand and others (supra)* within a period of **02** months.

5. Needless to mention that if upon considering the said representation, in case any monetary benefit is found due and payable to the petitioners, the same shall be disbursed in their favour within a further period of **01** month.
