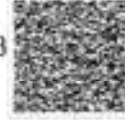

1. After arguing for sometimes, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that to redress the grievance raised in the present petitions with regard to wrongful rejection of their nomination liberty be given to approach the Election Tribunal by filing Election Petition.
2. Learned counsel for the respondents raises no objection.
3. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the respondents may not raise any objection regarding limitation for filing the Election Petition.
4. It may be noticed that as of now, the Election has not yet been held and even as per the petitioners, the Election Petition can be filed within a period of 30 days from the date of Election. Hence, the apprehension raised that an objection qua limitation for filing the Election Petition will be raised, is only speculative and does not warrant discussion or order from this Court at

this stage. However, in case any such order is passed by Election Tribunal, the petitioners will be free to avail appropriate remedy in accordance with law.

5. Keeping in view the above, as prayed for, the present petitions are disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to avail appropriate remedy before the Election Tribunal to redress their grievances.

6. Pending application(s), if any, stands disposed of.
