The petitioners seek grant of anticipatory bail under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023 in case bearing FIR No.194 dated 18.07.2025 registered under Sections 125, 115(2), 351(2), 3(5) of BNS, 2023 and Sections 25 & 27 of Arms Act at P.S. Sadar Fazilka.

The learned counsel for the petitioners submits that in compliance of the order dated 25.08.2025, the petitioners have joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

A reply dated 18.09.2025 by way of an affidavit of Lavdeep Singh Gill, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police (HQ)-cum-Sub Division, Fazilka has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record. He on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioners are no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 25.08.2025 is made absolute. However, the petitioners shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS.

Petition stands disposed of.
