Status report by way of an affidavit of Prithiv Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police, HQ, Nuh has been filed on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4 and the same is taken on record.

It has been alleged in the status report that after receipt of notice of the present petition, an enquiry had been conducted by the local police and during the course of enquiry on 23.08.2025, respondent No.5 Sameer and girl named 'N' (name withheld) were informed to join the enquiry proceedings and in compliance thereof, they had joined the enquiry proceedings. Their statements were recorded, where they categorically stated that they had solemnized marriage with each other as per their own free will and were living in safe house. Victim further stated that neither she was kidnapped nor she was having any apprehension regarding any danger to her life and liberty. Statements of respondent No.5 and detinue have been placed on record as Annexures R2 and R3. During the course of

enquiry respondent No.7 also suffered statement that respondent No.5 is son of his elder brother named Jubair and he had solemnized marriage with deteune. He had not created any trouble or any danger to the lives and liberty for respondents No.5 and detenue. The enquiry proceedings were conducted in the village of the petitioner but the petitioner was not found present at his house. He was informed by phone for joining enquiry proceedings but he did not join the same. Regarding which DD No.14 dated 23.08.2025 was recorded in daily diary register, Police Station Akera, District Nuh (Annexure R-7). A copy of said DD report has been appended along with the status report. It has been alleged that after completion of enquiry, it was revealed that respondent No.5 and detenue have solemnized marriage as per their own free will and they were not apprehending any danger from the private respondents No.5 to 7. They are residing at safe house, Nuh as per their own free will. It has been further alleged that as per matriculation certificate of detenue, she was found to be a major.

So, keeping in view the aforesaid status report, no further order is required to be passed.

Present petition stands disposed of accordingly.
