1. Learned counsel submits that the petitioners are entitled to revised pensionary benefits as per the recommendations of the 6th Pay Commission made applicable w.e.f. 01.01.2016 in terms of the Punjab Privately Managed Recognized Aided Schools Retirement Benefits Scheme, 1992, letter dated 29.10.2021, Notification dated 27.06.2024 and order dated 11.07.2024 passed in CWP-3635-2023, regarding which a legal notice dated 05.05.2025, Annexure P-13, has been served upon the respondents, but the same has yet not evoked any response. She, on instructions, prays that a direction may be given to the respondents to decide the same in a time bound manner.

2. Learned State counsel has no objection to the limited prayer made.

3. In view of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 05.05.2025, within a period of 6 months, which this Court has no reason to believe the authorities would not address in a just, fair and reasonable manner. Upon doing so, after notice and hearing offered to them and if found entitled, grant the benefit forthwith. Needless to say, if the orders are adverse to their interest, the same shall contain reasons and the petitioners shall be free to seek legal redress thereupon.
