SUBHAS MEHLA, J (Oral):

1. Petitioner has filed petition under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for quashing of order dated 05.06.2025 (Annexure P-10) and order dated 06.08.2025 (Annexure P-11) whereby his bail has been cancelled and his presence has been secured through non-bailable warrants with a further prayer to allow the petitioner to continue to appear before the learned trial Court in FIR No.128, dated 21.02.2020, under Sections 408 and 420 of IPC, registered at Police Station Ballabgarh, District Fartidabad.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner failed to appear before the learned trial Court as notices were not received by the petitioner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Karan Veer Singh, Sr.DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. Learned State counsel submits that several

notices were issued and even zimni order dated 05.06.2025 shows that bailable warrants issued to the petitioner were also received back duly served but despite that he failed to appear as he was on interim bail during Covid period but after that he failed to appear before the trial Court.

4. Heard.

5. This Court finds no merits in the present petition and the same is dismissed. However, petitioner is directed to surrender before the learned trial Court on the next date of the hearing fixed by the trial Court and take all the pleas before it.

6. Present petition stands disposed of.
