M/s Baba Feed Store through its Proprietor Mangal Singh, has filed the present petition under Section 528 BNSS, 2023 for quashing of common order dated 15.07.2025 passed by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Pathankot, in cases bearing No.NI/39/2016, NI/40/2016, NI/41/2016 and NI/42/2016, whereby the application under Section 311 Cr.P.C. for recalling the complainant for further cross-examination was dismissed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, though initially submitted that the Trial Court erred in dismissing the application of the petitioner for recalling the complainant for further cross-examination as also that denial of such opportunity has caused serious prejudice to him (petitioner) and has violated the principles of natural justice, but on being told that the facts leading to the passing of impugned order have been discussed at length by the learned Magistrate and in the light thereof, impugned order does not suffer from any illegality, learned counsel contended that in the interest of justice,

only one opportunity be given to the petitioner to cross-examine the complainant.

Heard.

In view of the request made by learned counsel strictly one, final and last opportunity is afforded to the petitioner to cross-examine the complainant, in one day. This concession has been granted to petitioner subject to his paying costs of Rs.5000/- in each of the four criminal complaints to be deposited with District Legal Services Authority.

Disposed of.
