1. Prayer is for quashing of FIR No.0048 dated 16.03.2024 registered under Sections 326, 325, 323, 341, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Beas, District Amritsar Rural, on the basis of compromise.

2. On 01.10.2024, following order was passed:-

“Prayer is for quashing of FIR No.0048 dated 16.03.2024 registered under Sections 326, 325, 323, 341, 148, 149 IPC, registered at Police Station Beas, District Amritsar Rural, on the basis of compromise.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Mr. Ankush Rampal, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of the complainant/respondent No.2. He admitted the correctness of compromise and stated that he has no objection if this petition is allowed.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. J.S. Dhaliwal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State. He does not wish to file any

reply as the parties are stated to have effected the compromise.

So, the parties are directed to appear before the learned trial court/Illaq Magistrate on 04.11.2024 or any other date convenient to the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate and to get record their statements regarding compromise and after recording their statements, learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate, is directed to send the same along with his report regarding the genuineness of compromise on or before the date fixed in the instant petition specifically with regard to the following facts : 1. Number of persons arrayed as accused in the FIR. 2. 3. 4. Whether any accused is proclaimed offender. Stage of the trial/proceedings. Whether the compromise is genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence.

To come up on 18.12.2024 for awaiting the report.

A copy of this order be sent to the learned trial Court/Illaq Magistrate, through electronic mode, for compliance.

In case, the petitioners have not approached any Court seeking grant of bail, the needful is to be done by the petitioners within next 15 days and during the said period of 15 days, no coercive action is to be taken against the petitioners.”

3. On 07.01.2025, following order was passed:-

“The present application has been filed on behalf of the petitioner seeking grant of one more opportunity for recording the statement of parties with regard to compromise, in compliance of the previous order dated 01.10.2024 passed by this Court.

Counsel appearing on behalf of the private parties are ad idem that parties have entered into compromise.

In view of the above, one more opportunity is given to the parties to get record their statements by appearing before the Court concerned within next 3 months and thereafter, the trial Court is to submit its report in compliance of the earlier order dated 01.10.2024 by the next date fixed in the present petition.

CRM is allowed.
