The jurisdiction of this Court has been invoked under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus seeking direction to the respondents to regularize the services of the petitioner as per instructions dated 07.03.1996 (Annexure P-7) and notification dated 01.10.2003 (Annexure P-8) from the date of his initial appointment when his juniors were regularized and release all the consequential benefits together with interest.

Sharma and Others v. State of Haryana and Others, CWP No. 2158 of 2020,
decided on 13.03.2024.
