The petition has been filed *inter alia* seeking a writ of *certiorari* quashing the final result and waiting list dated 19.12.2019 and 13.01.2020, Annexures P-6 and P-7 respectively, for the post of Laboratory Technician, pursuant to advertisement 02/2019 by excluding marks under the socio-economic criteria and experience given to the candidates.

2. The prayer is based on the premise that the marks could not have been awarded as the criteria has been declared unconstitutional by the Division Bench vide judgment dated 22.05.2025, rendered in CWP-16904-2021 titled *Neeraj v. State of Haryana and another*, and connected matters. Apparently, the selection in question stands finalised much prior to declaration of law by this Court, which cannot have any retrospective effect.

3. Accordingly, there is no ground to entertain the petition, and it stands dismissed *in limine*.
