1. Report of Warrant Officer has been received, as per which he along Sukhwinder Singh (brother-in-law of petitioner) had gone to the Police Post, Mavi Kalan, on 19.08.2025, where the detainee was found standing outside the main gate of the police post and was identified by Sukhwinder Singh. He had recorded the statement of detainee Bikram Singh that he was kept in custody and was extended threats by the police official and has been released only some time back. As per this report, ASI Ranjit Singh had informed the Warrant Officer that the detainee was never called upon by the police.
2. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks withdrawal of the present petition, at this stage.
