The petition has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to grant the petitioner benefit of second ACP for the post of TGT Social Science Master.

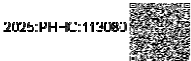
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the claim for grant of LTC/HTC for the block year 2024-27, and seeks liberty to make a fresh representation to that effect to the second respondent/Director, Secondary Education.

3. Ordered accordingly.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that grievance regarding second ACP is pending for appropriate decision before the respondents. At this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case the third respondent is directed to decide the pending legal notice, dated 18.06.2025, Annexure P-15, in a specified period.

5. Notice of motion.

6. Ms. Tanushree Gupta, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents/State and submits that the pending



legal notice, dated 18.06.2025, will be decided by the third respondent/Director, Elementary Education, by passing a speaking/reasoned order in accordance with law within a period of three months.

7. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.

8. Ordered accordingly.

9. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioner.
