By virtue of the present application, applicants-respondent Nos.4 and 5 pray for placing on record their short reply. The same is taken on record subject to all just exceptions.

CRWP-8988-2025

In the short reply filed by respondent Nos.4 and 5, they have mentioned that they would have 'No-objection', if custody of their granddaughter Navroop Kaur, aged about 17 years, is handed over to petitioner, who is the mother and natural guardian. Respondent No.5, Smt. Rajinder Kaur, is present in the Court and has been questioned. She does not object to request of petitioner rather states that it would be in the interest of minor granddaughter, if the girl is handed over to her mother. Incidentally, the minor female Navroop Kaur is also present in the Court. She has also been questioned and has expressed her desire to
