1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case FIR No.548 dated 11.08.2024, registered under Sections 109(1)/190/191(2)/191(3)/351(2)/61/191(1)/132/221/121(1) of BNS, 2023 and Section 25 of Arms Act, at Police Station Rania, District Sirsa.
2. By virtue of order dated 16.10.2024, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join the investigation.
3. Learned Senior counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated with the same and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.
4. Learned Senior counsel for the complainant has opposed the submissions made by learned Senior counsel for the petitioner.
5. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Prithvi Singh has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is



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no more required for further investigation.

6. In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 16.10.2024 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
