(1) Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage he would be satisfied if the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1-Additional Chief Secretary to Govt. of Punjab, Revenue Department, Punjab Civil Secretariat, Chandigarh to take a decision on the legal notice dated 15.03.2025/09.04.2025 (Annexure P-14) moved on behalf of the petitioner.

(2) Learned State counsel, who appears on advance notice, has no objection if the above prayer is accepted.

(3) Accordingly, at this stage, without commenting on the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1-Additional Chief Secretary to Govt. of Punjab, Revenue Department, Punjab Civil Secretariat, Chandigarh to take a decision on the aforesaid legal notice
