The petition has been filed seeking a direction for transfer of investigation of case FIR No.128 dated 22.08.2024, registered under Sections 171-G, 218, 465, 469, 471 and 120-B of IPC, at Police Station Baghapurana, District Moga, to some other police station for fair investigation.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that none of the ingredients of the alleged offences is made out against the petitioner, and lodging of the FIR is *mala fide* for extraneous reasons. The police are not fairly investigating the case, hence the prayer.

3. Learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for the fifth respondent, contend that they have no objection to the prayer made.

4. In view thereof, the petition is allowed. The investigation of the case FIR No.128 dated 22.08.2024, registered under Sections 171-G, 218,



465, 469, 471 and 120-B of IPC, at Police Station Baghapurana, District Moga, is hereby transferred to the nearest police station in district Faridkot.
