1. The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 439 of the Cr.P.C. with a prayer to grant regular bail in case FIR No.101 dated 17.06.2021 registered under Section 15, 15-C of NDPS Act, 1985 and Section 29 of NDPS Act added later on, at Police Station Vario Ke, District Fazilka.

2. Vide order dated 16.11.2023 passed by this Court, the petitioner was ordered to be released on interim bail in the present case.

3. Learned State counsel has informed the Court that the petitioner had already undergone the actual custody of 02 years and 05 months before being released on interim bail. Now, the petitioner is regularly appearing before the trial Court and apparently, there was no misuse of the concession of bail.

4. Consequently, the present petition is allowed and the interim order dated 16.11.2023, passed by this Court is made absolute. The petitioner shall continue to appear before the trial Court on each and every date of hearing and



shall not remain absent during trial proceedings, without prior permission of the trial Court.

5. In the end, I record my appreciation for Mr. Balram Singh, learned Amicus Curiae, who had rendered able assistance to this Court.
