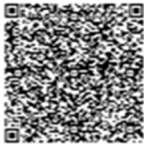

Fourth petition has been filed under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of bail pending trial to the petitioner in FIR No.72 dated 17.05.2021, under Sections 341, 323, 302, 365, 148 read with Section 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (*for short 'IPC'*) [Sections 364, 120-B, 216 added; whereas Section 365 IPC deleted later on]; Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Rojka Meo, District Nuh.

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(2) It transpires that regular bail of the petitioner was declined by learned trial Court wayback on 25.05.2023; thus, in the intervening period, much water has flown.

(3) In view of the above, this Court deems it appropriate to dispose off the petition with liberty to the petitioner to approach learned trial Court for seeking bail pending trial.

(4) So ordered.

(5) It is clarified that above observations be not construed as an expression of opinion on merits of the case in any manner.
