1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in a case FIR No.88 dated 26.07.2024, registered under Sections 333, 324(4), 115(2), 351(2), 351(3), 190, 191(3) of BNS, 2023, at Police Station Sultanwind, Amritsar.
2. By virtue of order dated 01.10.2024, while granting interim protection, the petitioners were directed to join the investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioners have joined the investigation and fully cooperated with the same and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.
4. Status report by way of affidavit of Pravesh Chopra, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, South, Amritsar filed in Court today is taken on record. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Avtar Singh has affirmed the fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation and they are no more required for further investigation.
5. In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 01.10.2024 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
