On 22.08.2025, the following order was passed:-

*“The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023 for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case registered against him vide FIR No.89 dated 05.07.2025 under Sections 115(2), 118(2), 191(3), 190 of the BNS, 2023 at Police Station Mallanwala, District Ferozepur.*

*The learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that no injury has been attributed to the petitioner and the injury attracting Section 326 IPC is attributed to one Mahavir Singh.*

*Notice of motion.*

*Mr. M.S. Toor, AAG, Punjab, present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of the State.*

*Adjourned to 22.09.2025.*

*In the meantime, the petitioner is directed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation and in the event of his arrest, he shall be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of SHO/Investigating Agency, subject to the following conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS:-*

*(i) that the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation before the investigating officer as and when required;*

*(ii) that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case as to dissuade him/her from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;*

*(iii) that the petitioner shall not leave the country without prior permission of the Court and shall surrender his passport, if any.*

*Meanwhile, the State is directed to file an affidavit/reply as to the exact role of the petitioner and his co-accused alongwith the details of pending FIRs, if any, on or before the next date of hearing.”*

As the petitioner is not joined investigation, I find no merit in the present petition and the same stands dismissed.
