SURYA PARTAP SINGH. J.(Oral)

1. Allegations in this petition filed by the petitioner is that he is facing trial for the commission of offence under Sections 384, 387, 504, 506, 120-B of IPC, 1860 read with Section 66 of Information Technology Act, 2000, and that in view of allegations contained in the FIR, no offence under the aforesaid Section is made out.
2. However it has been informed that investigation in this case is already complete and the final report/challan has been filed by the Investigating Agency before the learned trial Court.
3. The grounds taken in the petition can be raised by the petitioner at the time of hearing on the point of framing of charge. In such circumstance no cause for survival of this petition, seeking quashing on the
