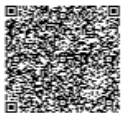

SURYA PARTAP SINGH. J.(Oral)

1. This petition seeking correction of order dated 28.07.2025 passed by learned coordinate Bench of this Court has been filed on the ground that contentions raised by learned counsel for the respondent, contained in para No.2 was false.

2. A perusal of the record shows that by virtue of above mentioned order, the petition filed by the petitioner was disposed of by observing that once the trial Court is seized of the matter regarding the sealed envelope, this Court is not inclined to entertain the petition on the same issue. Besides that, so far as the prayer for protection of petitioner's life and liberty is concerned, the proper remedy available to the petitioner is to approach the authorities concerned. Accordingly, the petitioner is granted liberty to move an appropriate application before the concerned



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Senior Superintendent of Police, who will look into the matter and take action in accordance with law by making an independent assessment at its own level.

- 3. The contents of para No.3 which was basis for arriving at a decision in the above mentioned petition shows that any finding was not recorded in the backdrop of information given by the respondent, which is claimed to be false by the petitioner.
- 4. In such circumstances, no ground for modification of above mentioned order is made out.
- 5. This petition stands dismissed, accordingly.
