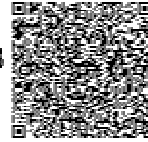

1. In the present appeal, it is sought to be contended on behalf of the appellant that identically placed persons as the present appellant, have been awarded 'three' marks for post-graduate degree and, therefore, the contrary view taken by the authorities in respect of the present appellant is unsustainable.

2. We have confronted the counsel for the appellant on the above submission and find that such plea does not appear to have been dealt with by the learned Single. It appears that this plea was in fact not raised before the learned Single Judge.

3. Once that be so, the appropriate course available to the appellant would be to approach the learned Single Bench and we would not be justified in entertaining the argument, which was not the basis of the claim before the learned Single Judge.

4. In that view of the matter, the appeal is allowed to be withdrawn with liberty to avail the permissible remedies before the learned Single Judge, in terms of the above observations.
5. All pending misc. application(s), if any, also stand disposed of.
