Prayer in the instant petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members and also to decide the representation dated 05.08.2025 (Annexure P3).

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has already moved a representation dated 05.08.2025 (Annexure P3) before respondent No.2 and 3, but no action on the same has been taken till date. He submits that he would be satisfied if respondent No.2 is directed to look into and decide the said representation.

Mr. Navdeep Singh, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice and submitted that he has no objection if the aforesaid representation dated 05.08.2025 is looked into.
