1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 528 of the Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking directions to the official respondents to take appropriate action against private respondents, who inflicted severe injuries with an intention to kill the petitioner. Further prayer has been made to direct the respondents to constitute a SIT of senior officials of the rank of IPS officers for conducting proper and fair investigation on the grievance of the petitioner and for direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representations dated 30.05.2022 and 23.08.2022 (Annexures P-2 and P-3) moved by the petitioner, during the pendency of the petition.

2. On 26.11.2024 following order was passed: -

“Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Gurdeep Singh, submits that the petitioner himself made a statement on 02.06.2022, submitting that the matter stands compromised and he does not want to take any action. Even a written compromise duly signed by



various persons has also been submitted. In view of this, the representations dated 30.05.2022 and 23.08.2022 (Annexures P-2 and P-3, respectively), stood closed and in this regard even a General Dairy Entry No. 25, dated 02.06.2022 has also been made. The said documents are taken on record. A copy of the documents have been given to learned counsel for the petitioner, who prays for a short accommodation to go through the same.

Adjourned to 03.12.2024.”

3. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition.
4. Dismissed as withdrawn.
